

Liturgical Seasons

Dec. 1, 2024 – Jan. 12, 2025: Advent, Christmas
Jan. 13 – Mar. 4, 2025: Ordinary Time (Weeks 1 to 8)
Mar. 5 – June 8, 2025: Lent, Triduum, Easter
June 9 – Nov. 29, 2025: Ordinary Time (Weeks 10 to 34)
Nov. 30, 2025 – Jan. 11, 2026: Advent, Christmas



Colors

In the liturgical calendar, the color for each day corresponds to that day's main liturgical celebration, even though Optional Memorials (perhaps with a different color) might be chosen instead. The four main colors shown are:

Jan 22: Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

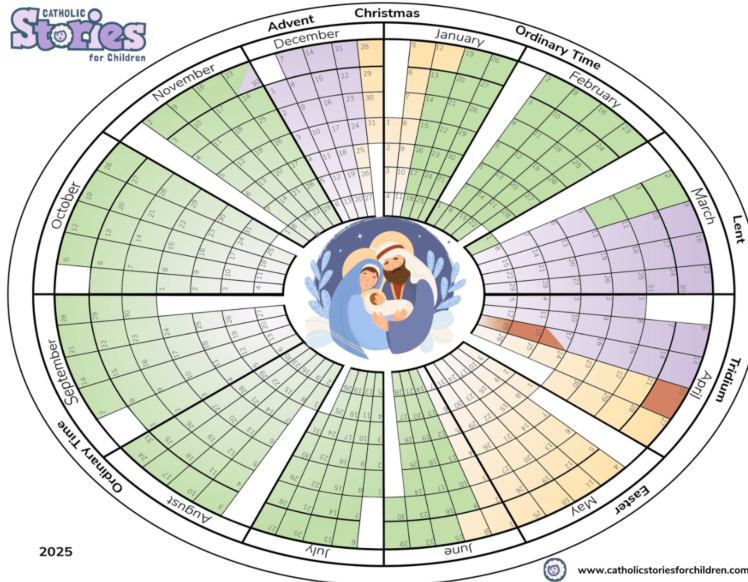
Mar 5: Ash Wednesday

Mar 25: Solemnity of the Annunciation

Apr 13: Palm Sunday
Apr 17-Apr 20: Easter Triduum
Apr 20-Apr 27: Octave of Easter
Apr 27: Divine Mercy Sunday

*May 29 or June 1: Solemnity of the Ascension
(May 29 in the ecclesiastical provinces of Boston, Hartford, New York, Omaha, and Philadelphia)

June 8: Pentecost Sunday
June 15: Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity
June 19: Corpus Christi?
*Holy Days of Obligation (All Sundays are also Holy Days of Obligation)
