### The Match Points system explained

The Union that wins the Match will be awarded four Match Points or (if it scores four tries or more in the process) five Match Points.

The Union that loses the Match will be awarded no Match Points or (if it scores four tries or more in the process or loses by a margin of seven points or fewer) one Match Point or (if it scores four tries or more in the process and loses by a margin of seven points or fewer) two Match Points.

Unions that draw a Match will each be awarded two Match Points and any of them that scores four tries or more in the process will be awarded a further one Match Point.

A Union that wins all five of its Matches (a 'Grand Slam') will be awarded a further three Match Points.

Use the coloured tables at the top to record the score. Use the grey tables to record the Match Points scored in each match.

### The trophy

The trophy goes to the team with the highest number of Match Points.

If two or more teams are equal, they are placed based on the difference between the total points scored and the total points conceded on the fields of play in all matches.

If a team defeats all 5 other teams they get the title 'Grand Slam Winner'.

If one of the four Home teams (England, Ireland, Scotland or Wales) defeats the other three they are awarded 'The Triple Crown'.
