Yule

December 21st - January 1st

- 12-day celebration
- No fighting and quarrel
- Hang mistletoe and wreaths
- Sacrifices to Odin for victory and to Freyr for a good crop
- Sacrifice and eat pork
- Drink mead and swear oaths
- Time of gifts
- Burn Yule Log

Ostara

March 20nd - 21st

- Make offerings to Freyja
- Celebration of fertility and growth
- Time to sow and plant seeds
- Make a bonfire
- Bake Ostara Bread
- Drink dandelion tea

Midsummerblót

June 21st - 22nd

- Make a bonfire and jump over it
- Play music, sing, and dance
- Burn corn dollies
- Make flower crowns and wear them
- Midnight swim
- Leave offerings on graves and honor your ancestors

Höstblót

September 22nd - 23rd

- Play games/sports
- Harvest latest vegetables
- Make a bonfire, sing, and dance
- Honor Freyr and Njord and make sacrifices to them
- Reflect your achievements

Disablót

February 2nd

- Preparation of the land for planting
- Honor the souls of women in your family line
- Make offerings to Forseti and Ullr
- Make a feast to celebrate the upcoming warm seasons
- Light candles and lanterns
- Time for sweets and chocolate
- Be grateful for the good relationships in your life

Majblót

April 30th - May 1st

- Singing, dancing, costumes, and pranks
- Ward off evil spirits with loud noises
- Good time to marry
- Good time to become pregnant
- Celebrates love and fertility
- Honor Freyr, Freyja, and Thor
- Start of summer nights

Freysblót

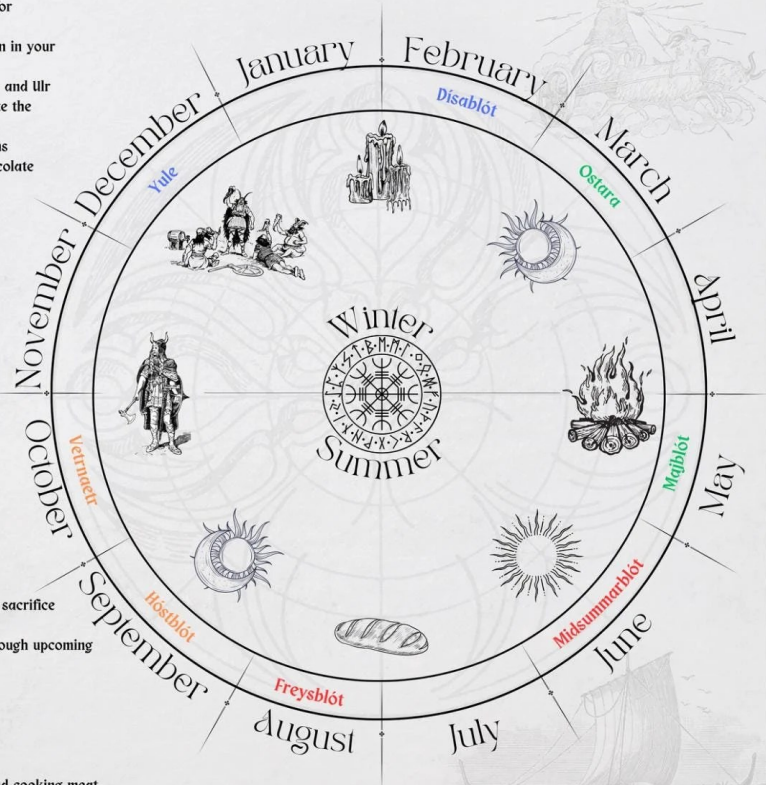
August 1st

- First day of harvest
- Bake a loaf of bread for sacrifice
- Sacrifice to Freyr
- Make offerings to go through upcoming winter nights
- Focus on good things

Vetrnaetr

October 29th - 31st

- Start of winter nights
- Good time for hunting and cooking meat
- Honor goddess Hela
- Good time for divination and connection with ancestors
- Leave food on ancestors' graves
