

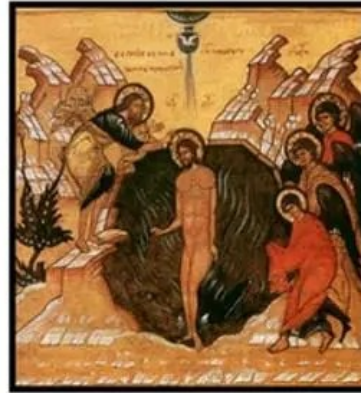


Nativity of Christ (Jan 7)

The Nativity of Christ signifies the beginning of Jesus' earthly mission to redeem humanity from sin. It represents hope, renewal, and the promise of eternal life. In the Gospel of Matthew and Luke, the birth of Jesus is heralded by angels, visited by shepherds and wise men, and proclaimed as the arrival of the Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

Holy Theophany of Christ (Jan 19)

Holy Theophany commemorates the baptism of Jesus Christ in the Jordan River by John the Baptist, as described in the Gospels of Matthew (3:13-17), Mark (1:9-11), and Luke (3:21-22).
