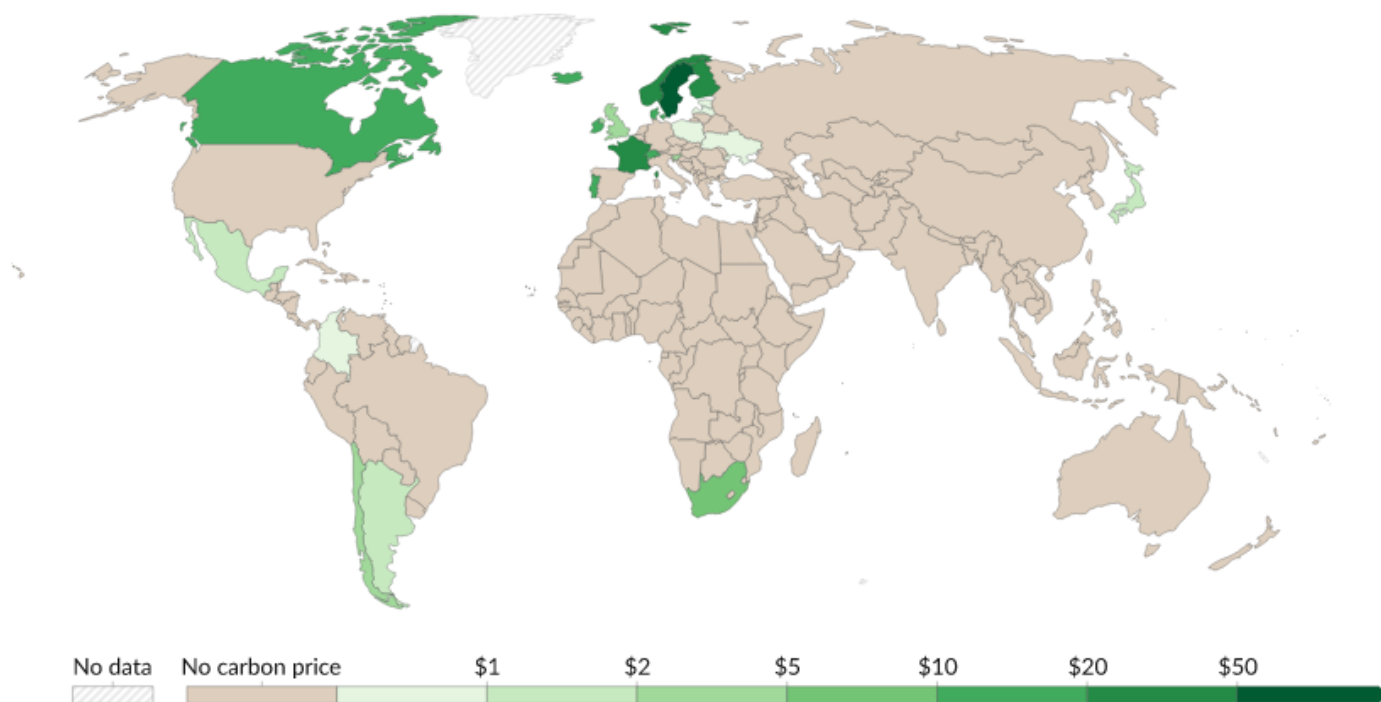


Emissions-weighted carbon price, 2021

The emissions-weighted carbon price is calculated for the whole economy by multiplying each sector's (e.g. electricity, or road transport) carbon price by its contribution to a country's carbon dioxide emissions.
