### NOTES

These are the final dates of approval by the Faculty Senate. Once the proposal is approved by the College Curriculum Committee (entered in Quali by the submission deadline), the proposal then goes to the Curriculum & Standards Committee, or the Graduate Council, and then to the Faculty Senate Meeting.

New ABM Specializations are reviewed first by the Curriculum & Standards Committee, then by Graduate Council, and then go to the Faculty Senate.

The committees meet once a month. If a proposal has been tabled by a committee, it cannot be approved until the next month. We recommend planning 12 months in advance.

### Footnotes

*\*New degree programs and organizational changes require approval of the URI Board of Trustees. The BOT Academic Affairs & Research Committee meets every September, November, February, April, and June (or thereabouts), and must be approved at the Faculty Senate prior to being reviewed by the BOT.*
