# Republican Policy Agendas Would Harm Millions of Children, Seniors, and Disabled People

Selected cuts in Republican Study Committee (RSC) plan and Project 2025



**800,000 preschoolers, toddlers, and infants would lose early learning services** under Project 2025's elimination of Head Start.



**Nearly 17 million kids in low-income families would receive less to buy food** under the RSC plan to cut SNAP benefits for all participants.



**7.5 million seniors and disabled people would be at risk of losing cash assistance** under the RSC plan to convert 50-year-old Supplemental Security Income to a block grant.
