## Parent A

**Annual Income**  
\$60,000  
**Current Value of Assets**  
\$80,000



## Parent B

**Annual Income**  
\$120,000  
**Current Value of Assets**  
\$100,000

The answer is

**Parent B** ✓

Because Parent B **earns more income and has greater assets**, they will be identified as a contributor on Lindsey's FAFSA form.
