4. Add lines 1, 2, and 3. This is your adjusted gross income.		
5. Deductions for children or your spouse if you qualify for dependents, check the applicable boxes below and follow the boxes from the Worksheets on page 2. <input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No If you do not qualify for your spouse (if you're married), enter \$10,000 if single; \$20,000 if married filing jointly. See line 6 for explanation.		
6. Deductions for itemized deductions. If line 5 is larger than line 6, enter 0.		
7. Standard deduction. All withheld from Monthly W-2 and 1099s.		
8. Itemized deduction credit (see instructions). <input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No Add lines 8a, 8b, 8c for your state's exemption and credits.		
9. ALWD. Use the ALWD boxes on line 6 above to find your ALWD in the 20 state in the instructions. Then, move the ALWD boxes on line 6 above.		
10. Health care and medical expenses (see instructions). Full self-coverage. <input type="checkbox"/> Yes <input type="checkbox"/> No Add lines 10 and 11. Then to your total line 6.		
11. If line 6 is larger than line 12, subtract line 12 from line 6. This is your refund. If line 6 is less than line 12, check here <input type="checkbox"/> Yes		
12. Refund Name exactly as printed on your Monthly W-2 and 1099s John Doe, Jr.		
13. If line 12 is larger than line 11, subtract line 11 from line 12. This is your tax due. If line 12 is less than line 11, check here <input type="checkbox"/> Yes
