Inclement Weather Make-Up Days:

The status of any day in the school calendar can be changed at any time during the school year if days are missed due to inclement weather. All days (except Sundays) between August and June, no matter how they are designated on the school calendar (holidays, workdays, AL days, Saturdays, etc), may become a make-up school day or workday. The make-up schedule will be announced as soon as possible after an inclement weather event has ended. If a Saturday is used as a make-up day, it shall occur as soon as possible following the missed instructional day.

- Calendar has to have 215 teacher days (this includes Student Days, Annual Leave Days, Work Days, and Holidays)
- Minimum of 9 teacher workdays (at least two have to be optional).
- Minimum of 10 AL days.
- State Holidays for 2025 - 2026: 9/1, 11/11, 11/27 - 28, 12/24-26, 1/1, 1/19, 4/3, 5/25
- At least 5 required workdays to start the year and start in the middle of week.
- The first semester needs a minimum of 86 days of instruction.
- Students have to have 1,025 hours of instruction.
- As a reminder, the numbers in the white cells - 3rd line under each month - are the number of student instructional days.
