

International Student Orientation (ISO) Timeline



Pre-Arrival

- F-1 students: Obtain your Form I-20 from OISA, pay the [I-901 SEVIS Fee](#), and obtain your [F-1 visa](#) at a U.S. embassy/consulate.
- Complete ISO Student Registration Form in WesPortal.
- Do Get Ready for Wes Online Orientation, including "International Students" section.
- Review FAQs below and [New Students](#) pages of OISA website.



Arrival Period

- F-1 students: You may enter the U.S. within 30 days before the program start date (Form I-20).
- Arrive to campus 9:00a.m. - 5:00p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST)
- Receive your room key and move into campus housing
- Free shuttles from Bradley International Airport (BDL) to campus.

Settle-in day

- Community-building activities with your ISO group.
- Shopping trip in Middletown with free shuttles organized by Office of International Student Affairs (OISA).
