Days are reckoned as beginning on the first date at sunset and ending on the second date at sunset. The scriptural New Year starts with the new moon of Abib from Jerusalem, as stated in Isaiah 2:3, "...for out of Zion will the law go forth, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem." The new moon can be predetermined per examples in 1 Sam., 20:5 & 18. Abib 1 is the beginning of Year 30 of the 70th Jubilee cycle, calculated from when the Israelites began the count for the first Jubilee Cycle in 1386/1385 B.C.E. in the land of Kaanan. The Exodus occurred in 1439/1438 B.C.E. There are 20 years remaining until the completion of the 70th Jubilee, which occurs in the spring of 2045 C.E.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Passover Day begins on the 14th day of Abib and is Day 1 of the 7-day Festival of Passover/Unleavened Bread. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 12:6 – 20, 13:3 –10, 34:18; Lev. 23:5, 23:7; Num. 9:2 – 3, 28:16 – 25; Deut. 16:1–4, Ezekiel 45:21; Matt. 26:17; Mark 14:12; Luke 22:7.

Festival Day 7 and last day of the 7-day Festival of Passover/Unleavened Bread. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 12:16, 13:6–7; Lev. 23:8; Num. 28:16–25; Deut. 16:8.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The day after the weekly Sabbath of Passover Week/Unleavened Bread. Listed to determine Pentecost. Lev. 23:9–11.

Fiftieth day from the Wave Sheaf Offering. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Note: the Siwan date will change with the Gregorian date from year to year. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:15–16; Deut. 16:9.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> First day of seventh month. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Lev. 23:23 – 25; Num. 29:1.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> Tenth day of seventh month. A day of fasting. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Lev. 16:29 – 31, 23:26 – 32; Num. 29:7.

The first day of the 8-day Festival of Ingathering. This day along with the next 6, which make up the first 7 days of the Festival of Ingathering, are also referred to as the Festival of Tabernacles. This day is also a High Sabbath and Sacred Convocation. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:33 – 39; Num. 29:12; Deut. 16:13; John 7:10.
